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AIM

The INNOVET project wants to develop and test a format of transnational conference where VET practitioners from all over Europe can develop innovation starting from the exchange of practices on themes at the top of the EU agenda with a particular emphasis on: teachers and trainers' professional development and an intense exchange of practices during transnational events.

OBJECTIVES

INNOVET will focus on two aspects that are considered of primary importance: a transversal subject - **Internationalisation**, and a vocational subject - **Technology and Industry 4.0**.

INNOVATIVE ELEMENTS

The innovative aspects being proposed by INNOVET are related to two main aspects:

- Deepen the analysis of two top priority areas in the field of VET
- Deliver a format for a one-stop-shop conference, where schools can exchange good practices and collaborate in joint follow-up initiatives

INNOVET will address 7 target groups, each of them will be involved in 2 interconnected level of participation:

- Direct involvement: VET TEACHERS, HEADMASTERS, MOBILITY EXPERTS STAFF
- Indirect involvement: VET STUDENTS, BUSINESS ACTORS, CIVIL SERVANTS AND POLICY MAKERS, UNIVERSITIES AND RESEARCH CENTERS

- To improve the quality of the education for participating VET providers
- To raise awareness on the work done on internationalisation and technology and industry 4.0 of associated partners, VET providers, local and regional authorities (civil servants and stakeholders) in the field of education, business actors, universities and research centers, thanks to a collection of good practices which can be used to innovate the training courses
